

Decorative GOLD BUNNIES

AND EASTER FUN



his golden rabbit made from wood is a real eye-catcher.

Here, it is watching over an Easter basket filled with Lindt GOLD BUNNIES, LINDOR eggs and chocolate figures that will melt in your mouth. A few minutes later it'll be used as the starting point for an egg hunt.

Decorative GOLD BUNNIES

YOU WILL NEED:

- Strong plywood, approx. 4 mm thick
- Fretsaw, sandpaper
- Primer, paintbrush
- Gold metallic paint
- Broom handle or other round wood of desired height (e.g. 1 m)
- Colourful ribbons
- Wood glue, adhesive
- Basket
- Lindt GOLD BUNNIES, chocolate figures and LINDOR eggs

HOW TO MAKE:

- 1 Copy the rabbit template (see next page) to the desired size, cut out and place it on a piece of strong plywood measuring approx. 4 mm thick.
- 2 Cut out the rabbit using a fretsaw and smooth the edges using sandpaper.
- 3 Next, coat both sides of the rabbit with primer. Leave it to dry completely, then paint it gold.
- 4 Now, stick the rabbit to the round wood or broom handle. Leave it to dry completely!
- 5 Tie a ribbon with a GOLD BUNNY bell around the neck and stick the other ribbons to the back of the broom handle so that they dangle from the bottom of the rabbit.
- 6 Place the GOLD BUNNY decoration with the basket full of Lindt treats in the garden. If you don't have a garden, you can also display the rabbit in a flowerpot on the balcony.
