SCHOOL ACCREDITATION

The USG recognizes accreditation from the following accrediting bodies:

Applicants who attend a homeschool or high school not accredited by one of the above must document their RHSC units through the submission of a curriculum packet. The curriculum packet must include the course title, course description, learning materials utilized (textbooks, software, reading lists, etc.), year course was completed, course credits and grade earned, and the school, institution, or program through which the course was taken (homeschool program, private/public school, online program, postsecondary institution, etc.) for each RHSC unit completed. Institutions may require additional documentation and/or test scores to further assess subject matter competency and preparation for college-level coursework. Students attending non-accredited homeschools or high schools are encouraged to contact their institution of interest to learn more.

REQUIRED HIGH SCHOOL CURRICULUM

Freshman applicants must complete the 17 academic units of the USG's Required High School Curriculum (RHSC). The courses that satisfy the RHSC are provided on the USG's <u>Staying on Course</u> document.

HIGH SCHOOL GRADE POINT AVERAGE

A minimum High School Grade Point Average (GPA) is required and is based on the 17 RHSC units. High school numerical grades are converted to letter grades based on the conversion table provided by each high school and then converted to quality points as follows.

$$A = 4$$
 $B = 3$ $C = 2$ $D = 1$ $F = 0$

The GPA is calculated by dividing the total quality points by the number of high school units.

SAT/ACT SCORE REQUIREMENTS

The USG is continuing to waive SAT/ACT score requirements at 23 of the 26 institutions. The temporary waiver does not apply to the Georgia Institute of Technology, the University of Georgia, or Georgia College & State University. Under the waiver, institutions may admit students not meeting minimum test score and Freshman Index requirements if they meet a higher high school GPA requirement. This document provides the

requirements to be admitted both with and without test scores for Fall 2025-Summer 2026. Note: Starting with Fall 2026 admission, the test score waiver ends for Augusta University, Georgia State University (Atlanta Campus), Georgia Southern University (Statesboro and Armstrong Campuses), and Kennesaw State University.

FRESHMAN INDEX

The Freshman Index (FI) is calculated using an applicant's High School GPA and SAT or ACT scores.

SAT FI Formula: $500 \times (HS GPA) + 1.06 \times (SAT ERW + Math) - 74$

Example: A student with a 2.9 HS GPA and 480 SAT Evidence-based Reading & Writing/440 SAT Math would use the following FI calculation:

SAT FI =
$$500 \times (2.9) + 1.06 \times (480 + 440) - 74$$

SAT FI = 2351.2

ACT FI Formula: 500 x (HS GPA) + (ACT Composite x 42) + 88

Example: A student with a 2.7 HS GPA and 18 ACT Composite would use the following FI calculation:

$$ACT FI = 500 x (2.7) + (18 x 42) + 88$$

ACT FI = 2194

LEARNING SUPPORT PLACEMENT

Learning Support is a generic term for programs designed to assist students with collegiate work and are intended to serve students who need additional support in mathematics or English (reading/writing). The "default placement" for all students is in entry-level English and mathematics with corequisite Learning Support unless exemption criteria are met.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Eligibility for admission is determined after the college or university has completed a thorough review of an applicant's admission application and credentials. Meeting the minimums provided on this document does not guarantee admission.
